livelihoods. However, deforestat on and habitat loss and fragmentat on have been threatening the existence of countless plant and animal species leading to species extinct on and ecosystem degradation. Conservation and restorat on of forest ecosystem is essential for preserving biodiversity and safeguarding the ecosystem services.

Forests also play a crucial role in regulating the water cycle and help mitigate water scarcity by enhancing water retention, filtration, and infiltration. However, deforestation and land use changes have disrupted hydrological processes in many parts of the world, leading to water scarcity, soil erosion, and increased vulnerability to droughts and foods. Forest conservation measures such as riparian buf erizones, watershed management, and reforestation projects can significantly contribute to improved water quality and quantity and reduce the risk of water-related disasters such as foods and droughts.

The triple planetary crisis represents a serious threat and challenge to forests and forest sector. New solut ons are needed to tackle biodiversity loss and mit gat ng climate change, these will require changes in forest management and investments in forest-based solut ons – these can generate mult ple biodiversity and social benef ts through the conservat on, management, and restorat on of ecosystems. However, the level of investment in forests and forest sector needs to be increased.

Innovation is crucial for forest sector. It is paving the way for early wildfine detection, digitalization & automation in timber trade, carbon sinks-aerial photography and for betien data to inform evidence-based decision-making. Decisions based on data and analysis produce betien outcomes and help to find the adequate solutions to the threats posed by global environmental challenges including triple planetary crisis.

In conclusion, forests of er versat le solut ons to address interconnected planetary crises, including climate change, biodiversity loss, pollut on,
