TENTATIVE FORECAST OF THE PROGRAMME OF WORK OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST 2011

AFRICA

Liberia – (UNMIL)

Resolution 1938 (2010) of 15 September 2010

Para. 11: requests the Secretary-General to keep it regularly informed of the situation on the ground as Liberia enters this next critical phase, and to provide <u>by 15 August 2011</u> a report on the issues addressed in paragraphs 2, 5 and 9 of the resolution;

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by 15 August 2011.

Libya

Resolution 1973 (2011) of 17 March 2011

Para. 12: requests the Secretary-General to inform the Council immediately of any actions taken by the Member States concerned in exercise of the authority conferred by paragraph 8 of the resolution and to report to the Council within 7 days and every month thereafter on the implementation of this resolution, including information on any violations of the flight ban imposed by paragraph 6 of the resolution.

The Secretary-General is expected to report to the Security Council on 30 <u>August</u> 2011.

Somalia

Resolution 1964 (2010) of 22 December 2010

Para. 20 requests the Secretary-General to report on all aspects of this resolution every four months commencing 1 January and expresses its intention to review the situation, as part of his reporting obligations, as specified in the statement of the President of the Security Council of 31 October 2001 (S/PRST/2001/30) and Security Council resolutions 1863 (2009), 1872 (2009) and 1910 (2010).

S/PRST/2011/6 of 10 March 2011

The Security Council notes that the transitional period will end <u>in August 2011</u>. The Council urges all Somali stakeholders to participate in this meeting and play a role in finalising arrangements for ending the transition <u>in August 2011</u>. It notes its intention to keep the situation under review.

S/PRST/2011/10 of 11 May 2011

The Security Council reiterates its full support to AMISOM and underlines its intension to keep the situation under review.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by 30 August 2011.

ASIA

The situation in the Middle East, including the Palestinian Question

Resolution 1322 (2000) of 7 October 2000

Para. 7: invites the Secretary-General to continue to follow the situation and to keep the Security Council informed.
