## TENTATIVE FORECAST OF THE PROGRAMME OF WORK OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER 2011

## For information only/not an official document

This tentative forecast of the programme of work of the Security Council has been prepared by the Secretariat for the President of the Council. The forecast covers in particular those matters that may be taken up during the month pursuant to earlier decisions of the Council. The fact that a matter is or is not included in the forecast carries no implication that it will or will not be taken up during the month: the actual programme of work will be determined by developments and the views of members of the Council.

The Sudan – UNAMID Resolution 2003 (2011) of 29 July 2011 Para. Para. 22: requests the Secretary-General to include <u>in his reports</u> a comprehensive assessment of threats to security in Haiti and give particular attention to the protective environment for all, in particular women and children, and on progress in the sustainable resettlement of displaced persons, and to propose, as appropriate, options to reconfigure the composition of MINUSTAH.

The report of the Secretary-General dated 25 August 2011 (S/2011/540) is before the Security Council.

Para. 1: decides to extend the mandate of MINUSTAH as contained in its resolutions 1542 (2004), 1608 (2005), 1702 (2006), 1743 (2007), 1780 (2007), 1840 (2008), 1892 (2009), 1908 (2010) and 1927 (2010) <u>until 15 October 2011</u>, with the intention of further renewal.

The mandate of MINUSTAH will expire on 15 October 2011.

ASIA

Afghanistan – ISAF <u>Resolution 1943 (2010) of 13 October 2010</u> Para. 1: decides to extend the authorization of the International Security Assistance Force (ISAF) for a period of <u>12 months beyond 13 October 2010</u>.

The authorization of ISAF will expire on 13 October 2011.

Timor-Leste – UNMIT

Resolution 1969 (2011) of 24 February 2011

Para. 19: requests also the Secretary-General to keep the Security Council regularly informed of the developments on the ground and to submit to the Security Council, no later than <u>15 October 2011</u> and 26 January 2012, reports that include an update regarding the High Level Committee on Transition and progress concerning the critical tasks that will need to be accomplished post-election, and on planning concerning the United Nations presence in Timor-Leste beyond 2012 elections.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by 15 October 2011.

The situation in the Middle East, including the Palestinian question Resolution 1322 (2000) of 7 October 2000

Para. 7: invites the Secretary-General to continue to follow the situation and to keep the Security Council informed.

Middle East (Lebanon) – resolution 1559 (2004) S/PRST/2004/36 of 19 October 2004

Last para: requests the Secretary-General to report to the Security Council <u>every 6 months</u> on the implementation by the parties of resolution 1559 (2004).

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by 19 October 2011.

reconstruction process in post-conflict environments, and *recognizes* that the establishment of an effective, professional and accountable security sector is one of the necessary elements for laying the foundations for peace and sustainable development.

Second para: welcomes *t*he Secretary-General's efforts on security sector reform and takes note of his report entitled 'Securing Peace and Development: the role of the United Nations in supporting security sector reform' of 23 January 2008 (S/2008/39).
