AFRICA

Burundi - BNUB

Resolution 2027 (2011) of 20 Dec. 2011

Para. 14: requests the Secretary-General to keep the Council informed on the implementation of the mandate of BNUB and this resolution, with a briefing by the end of July 2012 and a report by <u>18 January 2013.</u>

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be submitted by 18 January 2013.

Central African Republic – BINUCA

Resolution 2031 (2011) of 21 Dec. 2011

Para. 1: decides to extend the mandate of BINUCA as recommended by the Secretary-General in his report (S/2011/739), until 31 January 2013.

The mandate for BINUCA will expire on 31 January 2013.

S/PRST/2001/25 of 26 Sep. 2001

Last para.: requests the Secretary-General to continue to keep it <u>regularly informed</u> of the activities of BONUCA and the situation in the Central African Republic, particularly in the

Guinea-Bissau - UNIOGBIS

Resolution 2030 (2011) of 21 Dec 2011

Para.17: requests the Secretary-General to report on progress made in implementing this resolution and the mandate of UNIOGBIS as outlined in resolution 1876 (2009) through a briefing in March 2012, a report in July 2012 and every six months thereafter.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be submitted in January 2013.

Libya – UNSMIL

Resolution 2040 (2012) of 12 March 2013

Para.14: requests the Secretary-General to report to the Security Council on the implementation of this resolution, including all elements of UNSMIL's mandate, every 60 days;

The Secretary-General is expected to report to the Security Council during January 2013.

Somalia

Resolution 2010 (2011) of 30. Sept 2011

Para. 29: requests the Secretary-General to report on all aspects of this resolution every four months and expresses its intention to review the situation, as part of his reporting obligations, as specified in the statement of the President of the Security Council of 31 October 2001 (S/PRST/2001/30) and Security Council resolutions, 1863 (2009), 1872 (2009), 1910 (2010) and 1964 (2010);

Somalia - recommendations on UN presence

Resolution 2067 (2012) of 18 Sept. 2012

Para. 21: looks forward to the Secretary-General's inter-agency review of the United Nations presence in Somalia, emphasizes the need to develop an integrated strategic approach to all activities of the United Nations system in Somalia, in close partnership with the Somali authorities and the African Union and in consultation with regional and international partners, and requests that he presents options and recommendations to the Security Council by 31 December 2012.

Letter from the President of the Security Council of 13 Nov. 2012 (S/2012/828)

Last para: the members have taken note of the request [by the Secretary-General] that the timeframe for the issuance of the report be extended, and they look forward to the submission of the report by 31 January 2013.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by 31 January 2013.

Somalia - AMISOM

Resolution 2073 (2012) of 7 November 2012

Para. 5: requests the African Union to keep the Security Council regularly informed, through the Secretary-General, on the implementation of AMISOM's mandate, and report to the Council, through the provision of written reports, 60 days after the date of this resolution;

The report of the Africa Union is expected to be submitted in January 2013.

Sudan - UNAMID

Resolution 2063 (2012) of 31 July 2012

Para.12: requests the Secretary General to continue reporting to the Council <u>every 90</u> <u>days</u> on progress in the implementation of UNAMID's mandate, including the operational and self-sustainment capabilities of troop and police contingents, as well as on progress on the political track, the security and humanitarian situation, including in the IDP sites and refugee camps, the actions of all parties with respect to the provisions of this resolution, human rights, violations of international humanitarian and human rights law, early recovery and on all restrictions and bureaucratic impediments to UNAMID's freedom of movement; requests the Secretary General, after consultation with the African Union, to submit in his next 90-day report updated benchmarks and indicators for UNAMID and to include in his regular reports to the Council every 90 days thereafter an assessment of progress towards and obstacles to the achievement of these benchmarks, so that the Council may assess progress made by UNAMID in implementing its mandate, as well as the co-operation of the Government of Sudan and the armed groups with UNAMID, as well as all parties' compliance with their international obligations;

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued during January 2013.

Sudan – UNISFA

Resolution 2075 (2012) of 16 November 2012

Para. 17: requests the Secretary-General to continue to inform the Council of progress in implementing UNISFA's mandate <u>in sixty-day intervals</u>, and continue to bring to the Council's immediate attention any serious violations of the above-referenced agreements;

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued during January 2013.

Sudan (Sudan/South Sudan)

Resolution 2046 (2012) of 2 May 2012

Para. 6: requests the Secretary-General to consult with the African Union on the implementation of this resolution and the decisions of the AU PSC, to work closely with the AUHH07(o)11.4807((t)-5.15273(h)0.5902515007(P)2.68538(S)2.6a)0.590251(u)0.59025estp0.958493(tp0.95

The Secretary-General will provide an update to the Security Council during its meeting on the rule of law in January 2013.

Peacebuilding Commission – selection of Security Council members

Resolution 1646 (2005) of 20 December 2005

Para. 1: decides that in addition to the permanent members of the Security Council, the Council shall select <u>annually</u> two of its elected members to participate in the Organizational Committee of the Peacebuilding Commission (PBC).

The Security Council is expected to announce in early January 2013 the two members elected to serve one-year terms on the PBC Organizational Committee for the year 2013.

Bureaux of the subsidiary bodies of the Security Council

The Security Council is expected to announce in early January 2013 (in a Note by the President to be issued as S/2013/2) the bureaux of Security Council subsidiary bodies for the year 2013.
