
WHAT IS GOAL 16 -PEACE, JUSTICE, AND STRONG INSTITUTIONS?




illicit arms, combating corruption, and ensuring inclusive participation at all times.

Peace is a fundamental precondition for social and economic development. Without peace, societies are often plagued b conflict, violence, and instabilit , hich can hinder progress and result in the loss of lives and resources.

Equal access to justice is essential for protecting the rights of individuals, resolving disputes, and ensuring that vulnerable populations are not marginali ed or mistreated.

Crimes threatening peaceful societies, including homicides, trafficking and other organi ed crimes, as ell as discriminator la s or practices, affect all countries.

WHAT IF WE DON'T TAKE ACTION?

Violence also affects children s health, development and ell-being, and their abilit to thrive. It causes trauma and eakens social inclusion.

Lack of access to justice means that conflicts remain unresolved and people cannot obtain protection and redress. Institutions that do not function according to leg timate las are prone to arbitrariness and abuse of poer, and less capable of delivering public service to ever one.

To e clude and to discriminate not onl violates human rights, but also causes resentment and animosit, and could give rise to violence.

WHAT CAN WE DO?

E ercise our rights to hold our elected officials to account, to freedom of information and share our opinion ith our elected representatives. Promote inclusion and respect to ards people of different ethnic origins, religions, gender, se ual orientations or different opinions.
